

**3rd ANNUAL CDNA HIGH SCHOOL JOURNALISM CONTEST  
RULES & APPLICATION**

1. Students at any public or private secondary school in the State of Connecticut are eligible to enter.
2. Each school may submit up to three entries per category. There is no limit to the number of categories which may come from a single school.
3. Only students actively enrolled at the respective school may submit entries.
4. All entries must be from published School newspapers of the present academic year.
5. All entries must be identified by student name, year of graduation, edition and page of such where appearing.
6. For verification purposes, schools are asked to send a complete copy of the issue in which an entry appeared. Please remember, each entry must be accompanied by a complete issue of the newspaper.
7. All materials submitted become the property of the Connecticut Daily Newspapers Association.
8. All competing schools and contestants agree to ascribe to all rules of ethical journalism.
9. Category judging will be up to the professional discretion of the respective judging panels.

**Non-compliance with any of the listed rules and expectations may automatically disqualify any entries and/or competing schools.**

Complete entries must be received no later than May 5, 2010.

Notification of winning entries will be made by Wednesday, May 19, 2010.

Awards Ceremony: June 8, 2010, 11 am at the Hartford Courant.
